THE FEATHERS THREE

Artist:
Kirk Seese

Materials:

Posts:
2" x 2" x 10', 12', 14' high, square tubular steel, primed & painted black

Bases:
16" x 16" x 1/2" thick square steel, primed & painted black

Panels:
4' high x 1' wide x 3/4" thick Medium Density Overlay Board, (MDO), primed, sanded, routed and printed

Rods:
3/8" x 8" long stainless steel

Protective Coating:
Clear acrylic sealer

Weight:
85 lbs per Feather

Process:

Weld the post to the base, prime & paint.

Print designs directly on the primed panels using a large, flatbed printer (both sides).

Apply acrylic sealer, (both sides).

Drill holes through panel edges and steel post for rods.

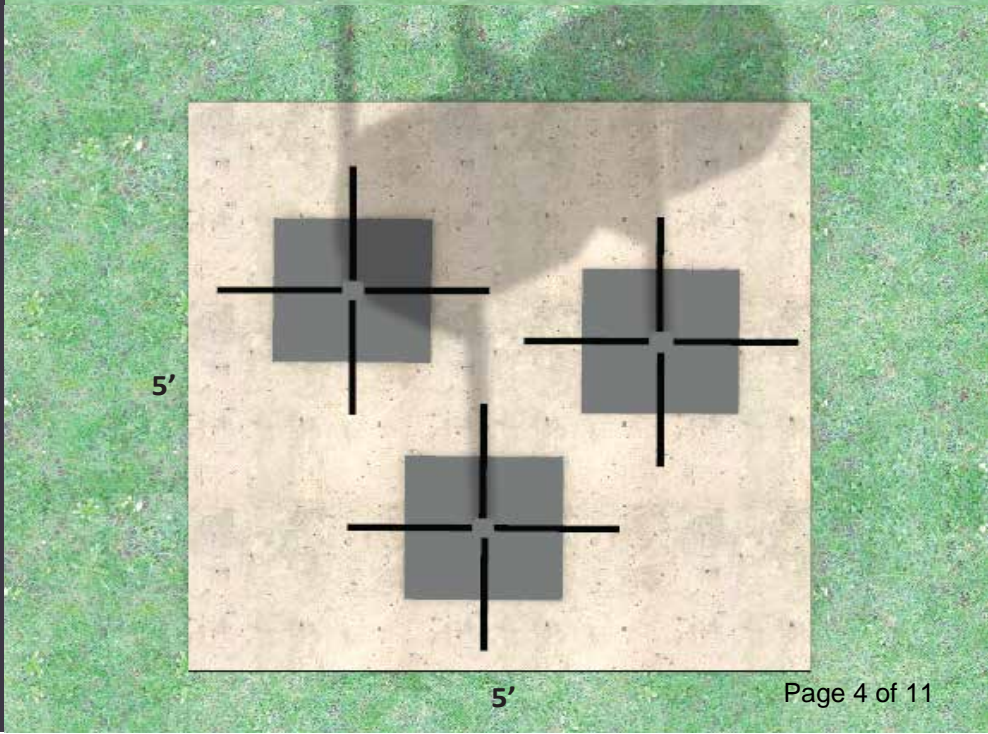
Feed rods through panels & post to attach.

Secure assembled Feather to a concrete base via anchor bolts.
