There is a vacancy in the position of Ward 4 Councilmember due to the passing of Tom Engert. The procedure for filling a City Council vacancy is outlined in City Code Section 110-145. The 14-day period for taking applications for the vacant Ward 4 position expired on September 10, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. There were three applications filed for the vacancy: Pam Hatcher, Mark Miller, and Eric Smith.

The City Council will interview all applicants and receive information from citizens who would be eligible to vote for them if they were running for election. If the Council concludes that a qualified candidate has been determined at this meeting, an appointment will be made so that the new member may participate in consideration of business at the September 28, 2026 regular City Council meeting. If the Council finds that no qualified person has applied, the process may be repeated until a qualified applicant has been appointed.
