A. Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement for Integrated Emergency Services

BILL 3914: "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF RAYMORE, MISSOURI, TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR FUNDING, OPERATION, AND ADMINISTRATION OF AN INTEGRATED PUBLIC SAFETY SOFTWARE SYSTEM."

City Clerk Erica Hill conducted the first reading of Bill 3914 by title only.

City Attorney Jonathan Zerr reviewed the staff report included in the Council packet. Bill 3914 seeks approval to enter into an Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement with the City of Harrisonville, the Cass County Sheriff's Office, the City of Belton, the City of Pleasant Hill, the City of Peculiar, and the Cass County Emergency Services Board (ESB) for the provision of computer-aided dispatch services, integrated records management systems and jail management systems maintained by the ESB. This will include the utilization of the CentralSquare Public Safety Pro Suite. The agreement will provide for the funding, operation, and administration of the CentralSquare software and equipment. City Manager Jim Feuerborn answered questions from Council.
